Reservations Required. The campsite and stall will be held until your arrival.

RENTAL FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE RIDING FEE + STALL FEE.

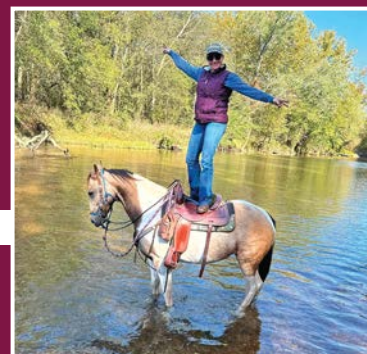

Fees Due upon arrival

Adults.....	\$25.00 per day, per adult
Child 8-12.....	\$ 5.00 per day, per child

RULES

The Buffalo River Trail Ride will enforce the following rules:



- Trail Bosses and their assistants have absolute authority on the trail.
- No rough riding or racing.
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the trail.
- If your horse damages a tree, you will be charged \$150.00 to replace the tree.
- Your camp must be quiet at midnight.
- No vehicles cruising the campground after midnight.
- No horseback riding after midnight.
- Pets, including Dogs and Cats, must be on a leash. No Dogs on Trails.**
- Food must not be taken from the dining facility without permission.
- Do not tie horses to trees or where they can reach trees. Wire, rope or electric pens are not allowed. Stakes and tether lines are not allowed.
- Bathing horses is not allowed in the Buffalo River.
- No riding motorcycles or ATVs in the campground area or on trails.*
- No firearms or other weapons allowed.
- No littering on or off the trails, **if you pack it out pack it in.**
- Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on organized rides.**
- If your horse kicks, you must tie a ribbon on its tail. Bring your own ribbon.
- Unauthorized vendors are not allowed to conduct business at the trail ride.
- We reserve the right to reject any reservation.**
- Do not tie horses to water hydrants or electrical posts.

State law PROHIBITS SMOKING in any enclosed building!

NOTE: Dogs cause accidents! If you cannot keep your pet on a leash, then please leave your pet at home. (Rule #8)

ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ON TRAILS!

Stallions are permitted, but must be under control at all times.

NOTE: If you arrive before “riders are welcome” date, you will be charged a camping fee of \$25 per day, per site.



Buffalo River Trails

Our trails are through some of the most breathtaking country in the Tennessee hills. Be prepared to cross sparkling streams, climb rugged hills, and pass through secluded hollows. Our beautiful trail system winds through thousands of acres. Our trail bosses work hard to ensure a safe and memorable experience for each rider. We offer four rides each day: a half-day slow, a half-day medium, a half-day gaited, and an all-day ride.

Meals

Your trail ride fee includes three buffet style meals each day, beginning Monday at breakfast and ending the following Sunday. Meals are served in the dining hall. All-day riders may pack a lunch. On arrival weekend meals can be purchased in the dining hall.

Camping

Camping at the spacious Buffalo River Trail Ride campground is a relaxing vacation all by itself, with 100 acres of campground and the beautiful Buffalo River all around us. Campsites with electric must be reserved. Potable water is available at the RV station.

Fishing

If you enjoy fishing, you'll love the Buffalo River; bass, bluegill and catfish are abundant in the clear water of the Buffalo, one of Tennessee's natural scenic rivers. Fishing licenses are available in Waynesboro or online at www.tn.gov/twra.

Location and Directions

Our campground is located 5 miles off Hwy 13 in north Wayne County, Tennessee. Take I-40 to HWY 13, go 44 miles south to the Buffalo River Trail Ride campground sign. From Waynesboro, go 7 miles north on Hwy 13 to the campground sign. 5929 Bromley Cemetery Rd., Waynesboro, TN. 38485

Belt Buckles

A beautiful custom-designed Buffalo River Trail Ride Belt Buckle is awarded to trail riders who attend at least one week long organized trail ride each year for five, ten, fifteen, twenty, twenty five and thirty years. To be eligible a full week fee must be paid.



Stalls

All barns are covered, with lights and water. Stalls must be reserved; Covered stalls are \$45 and box stalls are \$85 for the week. Stall cleaning fee is included in rental fee.

Picketing or Stock Panels

Picketing lines and gate panels are allowed. There will be a \$25 fee per horse to picket or pen. Do not picket or pen horses within an electrical campsite.

All Horses and Mules Must Be Tested

All horses and mules, in state and out-of-state must have proof of a negative Coggins Test. This is a STATE LAW REQUIREMENT.

What to Bring

You must furnish your sleeping facilities, we advise you to bring all tack and riding equipment, as well as rain gear and warm clothing. **WE DO NOT RENT HORSES.**

Liability

The Buffalo River Trail Ride makes every effort to ensure a safe week of trail riding. However, the Buffalo River Trail Ride cannot assume any liability for personal injuries, livestock injuries, or equipment damages. You ride the trails at your own risk and will be required to sign a release when you arrive.

Vendors

Buffalo River Trail Ride does not allow unauthorized vendors to conduct business at the trail ride.

Register Early and Reservation

Every rider/camper must register. There will be no exceptions. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis. We must receive your reservation and deposit before the deadline for reservation dates. All deposits are applied to the amount due. All campsites and stalls must be reserved. Reservations without a deposit will not be accepted. **We reserve the right to reject any reservation.**

NOTE: if you make a reservation, your campsite and/or stalls will be held for one week. If, we do not receive your deposit within one week, you forfeit your reservation; we will rent the campsite and stalls to someone else.

NEW REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

100% refund.....letting us know 31 days or more prior to the event.

50% credit.....to be used within the calendar year if we are notified 15-30 days prior to the event.

0% refund.....0-14 days prior to the event.

If you wish to cancel a reservation & receive a refund you must first call the office & notify us & we will then request it in writing via email (buffalorivertrailride@live.com).

Fees for 2025 Organized Rides

The following fees cover all trail rides, meals, use of all campground facilities, and entertainment. **ALL GUESTS MUST CHECK IN AND PAY FULL TRAIL RIDE FEES, WHETHER OR NOT THEY EAT THE MEALS OR RIDE.** We accept cash, money orders, travelers' checks and good personal checks. **Now accepting credit and debit cards, 3.5% usage fee applied. All foreign exchange must be in US Currency.**

NOTE: Tennessee State Sales Tax 9.75% collected on all fees.

IF YOU ARRIVE ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF THE RIDE, YOU WILL BE CHARGED THE WEEKLY FEE, (No exceptions) if, you arrive after the first day of the ride you will be charged daily fees.

ALL GUEST MUST SIGN IN AND PAY DAILY FEES, WHETHER YOU RIDE OR NOT.

Absolutely no refunds!

We do not refund fees under any circumstances.

No Refunds, Transfers or Cancellations Given Upon Arrival or During Ride.
